PROGRAM PURPOSE

The purpose of the conference is to provide health care professionals with information on how to deal with special situations in managing diabetes, including chronic complications from the inpatient to the outpatient arena.

INTENDED AUDIENCE

Nurses, dietitians, diabetes educators, UIC family medicine residents, medical, pharmacy and nursing students.

OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of the conference, participants will be able to:

1. List the controversies surrounding insulin pump management in an inpatient setting.
2. Recognize the early manifestation, screening and implications (morbidity and mortality) of diabetic renal disease and focus on the treatment modalities and treatment associated complications of diabetic renal disease.
3. Learn about the numerous transplant options for reversing diabetes and the indications for pancreas or islet transplantation depending on transplant type, improved clinical outcomes in both pancreas and islet transplantation and understand the donor and recipient factors which impact outcomes and the recent advances that have been made in this field.
4. Define the correlation between the obesity and diabetes epidemics, discuss the role of bariatric surgery in the treatment of obesity-related disease and its impact on disease management as well as future trends.
5. Discuss recommended screening and diagnosis guidelines for gestational diabetes (GDM) and identify two potential maternal and fetal complications associated with preexisting diabetes/GDM and pregnancy.
